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1. Welcome to HelpMyKidLearn

HelpMyKidLearn is a premium family learning platform for parents and caregivers who want a calm, sequenced way to support each child. This guide explains every feature, page, and workflow — written for adults, not marketing copy.

2. Creating Your Account

Visit </signup>, enter your email, and set a password. One adult account can manage several children — you do not need a separate account per child. Confirm your email if prompted, then sign in at </login>.

3. Parent Dashboard

Your dashboard at </dashboard> is mission control. It shows the active student profile, recent activity, saved worksheets, recommended pathway steps, and quick links to Library, Pathways, Plan, and Premium.

4. Student Profiles

Create a profile for each child with a name, grade, and focus subjects. Profiles shape recommendations and progress tracking. Children do not need their own login — supervised use by a parent or caregiver is the intended pattern.

5. Learning Pathways

Pathways are sequenced skill journeys. Open </pathways>, pick a subject, and follow the recommended order. Each step pairs a short concept with a practice activity so the child works, not just watches.

6. Worksheets & Guided Learning Experiences

Browse worksheets in the Library or by subject. Every worksheet includes parent notes, guided prompts, and an answer key. Use the Print button to render a print-ready A4 or Letter sheet with safe margins.

7. Printable Learning Packs

Printable packs combine a worksheet, a hands-on activity, and a parent prompt. Find them at /printable or from any subject hub. Packs use clean two-column layouts and always keep the answer key on its own page.

8. Learning Plan Builder

The Plan Builder at /plan and /builder assembles a weekly schedule from the active profile's grade and focus subjects. Regenerate anytime — nothing is locked in.

9. Progress Tracking

While signed in, completed pathway steps, saved worksheets, and finished packs are recorded against the active student profile. Progress feeds recommendations and appears on the dashboard.

10. Subject Libraries

Use the Subjects menu (Reading, Math, STEM, Writing, Science, and more) to open a curated library. Each subject hub includes an overview, recommended pathways, and the worksheets families use most.

11. Grade Libraries

The Grades menu opens grade-specific views (PreK through 8). Recommendations are grade-appropriate and can be narrowed by subject or skill.

12. Saved Resources

Tap the bookmark icon on any worksheet or article to save it to your account. Saved items live on the dashboard for quick return.

13. Search & Find

Use [/search](#) for a full-text search across the library. Use [/find](#) for guided discovery — pick a grade and subject and get a curated shortlist.

14. Educator Workspace

The Educator Workspace at [/classroom](#) groups resources for teachers, tutors, and homeschool co-op leads. Assemble packs, mark items as taught, and export a printable weekly plan.

15. Homeschool Center

The Homeschool Center at [/homeschool](#) is a guided workspace for full-time homeschool families — weekly plans, subject sequencing, and printable trackers.

16. Family Premium

Family Premium unlocks the full library, complete pathways, answer keys, and printable packs. Manage your plan at [/pricing](#). Redemption codes can be entered on [/pricing](#) or the dashboard.

17. Parent Resource Center & Knowledge Base
